

## English

In our English lessons this term, we will be building upon a different type of writing. This term we are focusing on newspaper writing, we will study different examples and create our own based upon our new topic! We will end our spring term off with a debate, this will also be focused on our topic and our environment. We will also continue to build upon our SPaG skills throughout.

## Geography/History

Through our exciting topic 'Our changing world', we will get the opportunity to work on our geographical skills. We will explore areas all around the world, studying both physical and human features comparing them to draw conclusions. We will be looking at land-use patterns, using this to describe how the world has changed over time. Finally, we will be looking at the term 'sustainable' and dive deeper into environmental issues and what is happening to our planet.

## Art and Design

We will be concentrating on Art this term. In Art, we will be researching artists that use climate change and the environment to create their pieces. We will use this inspiration to create our own. We will be using our sketchbooks to study and annotate different artists work.

## Music

As musicians, we will continue to use our voices to perform a variety of songs as a class. We will listen to a variety of music from around the world to link to our topic. We will perform songs as an group and explore solo roles.

## Mathematics

In Maths this term, we are continuing to focus and build on our mathematical fluency through regular basic skills sessions. We will also focus on percentages and linking this to our knowledge of fractions and decimals. Towards the end of term, we are going to move on and focus on algebra.

## Class 6 Spring 2021 Our changing world!

This spring term we will be studying our changing world. This geography-based topic will allow us to look at different human and physical features all around the world. We will look deeper into how the world has changed, why and what it might look like in the future!

## Physical Education

This term in PE, we will work creatively and imaginatively with a partner and in a group to compose motifs and structure simple dances in response to a variety of music stimuli. We will discuss dance with understanding and using appropriate language and terminology. We will also organise and lead warm ups and cool downs and understand the benefits of dance for our health.

## Languages

In languages, we will continue to focus on our French speaking skills using songs and rhymes to support our pronunciation. We will identify how to talk about animals and use this to write about our pets and favourite animals.

## Science

Our Science lessons will allow us to discover the concept of Electricity. We will deepen our knowledge of a simple electric series and the names for each component. We will carry out various experiments to find out the effects of a changing voltage and bulb brightness. We will make predictions and test these out.

## Religious Education

In RE this term, we will be focusing on the question 'What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?'

### PSHE

Our PSHE lessons will consist of looking at 'Healthy me' we will concentrate on factors that make us unhealthy and how to make choices that benefit our health and well-being.

## Computing

Our computing lessons will also link to our topic this term and we will be using our graphical skills to create information posters. We will also create and present a film for two different audience types. We will get the opportunity to get creative and to use our computing skills and to extend on these.
