We will be using the Talk4Writing approach and focusing on rags to riches tales, after exploring and unpicking a variety of texts the children will have the opportunity to write their own. We will draft and compose our own newspaper articles and write instructions independently. We will also use our Talk4Reading approach to develop our understanding of a range of text types and continue

Mathematics

We will focus on continuing to develop our mathematical fluency through regular basic skills sessions focusing on the four rules; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also investigate a range of problem solving strategies and extend our knowledge on place value, formal written methods and measurement.

Class 4 Autumn Term 2021

Sweet like Chocolate

This term we have chosen to learn all about chocolate, our exciting topic will enable us to answer the following questions; how is chocolate made? Where did it originate? How does it get to our shelves?

Languages

Religious Education In RE we will investigate the question, 'What is the Trinity and why is it important to Christians?' PSHE In our PSHE lessons we will continue to follow the Jigsaw scheme of work

and focus on 'being me in my world' and 'celebrating difference.'

One of our main areas of focus in computing will be looking at Internet safety. The children will use the iPad's to create their own animations on the journey of chocolate and use search engines to gather information.
