

## English

Throughout the summer term, we will be reading a range of challenging texts and discussing these in our 'Talk 4 Reading' sessions. In writing, we will begin by focusing on creating our own finding tale using our 'Talk 4 Writing' approach. We will continue to focus on our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills to ensure that these are used and applied effectively in our written work.

## History

In History this term we will be exploring crime through time! Our focus is crime and punishment throughout different periods starting with the Romans and leading through to modern day Britain. We will be comparing what has changed and what has stayed the same over the years.

## Physical Education

In PE this term we will be focusing on Rounders, Athletics and Cricket. We will be refining and improving our throwing, catching, bowling, batting and fielding skills. We will also be refining our tactical skills in games. In Athletics we will be focusing on improving our throwing, running and jumping skills. We will be running for speed and endurance and will be trying to achieve our best in all areas.

## Mathematics

In Maths we will continue to practise our skills using number. Our multiplication and division knowledge will be integral in using and applying this with our continuing work on fractions, decimals and percentages. In geometry we will be focusing on angles: estimating, comparing, measuring and drawing. Later on in the term we will visit measurement and learn how to convert between different units, such as: centimetres and metres, grams and kilograms.

## RE/PSHE

In RE we will continue exploring: 'Why is the Torah important for Jewish people?'  
In PSHE, we will be following the Jigsaw scheme thinking about 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'.

## Geography

## Science

Our scientific focus this term will begin with 'Living Things and Their Habitats' where we will investigate how plants reproduce, different life cycles of animals and the work of famous naturalist Jane Goodall. After half term, we will move on to exploring 'Animals including Humans' where we will be looking at the timeline of human growth and development, including the changes we experience.

## Computing

Our Computing focus this term will be databases. We will investigate the following questions: How do you create a formula in a spreadsheet? How can you search a database using symbols? How do you create a database? How do you create graphs and tables?

## Art and Design Technology

We will be combining our skills in our sewing project to create a final piece that includes different stitches and decorations, such as appliqué and embroidery.

## Languages

During the summer term we will continue to develop our French speaking, listening, reading and writing skills while building on our range of vocabulary and our ability to adapt words and phrases when communicating.
