

English

Our focus for the beginning of this term will be revising spelling, punctuation and grammar skills that we have learned. In writing, we will be looking carefully at applying these skills to different genres. Later in the term, we will look at formal and informal writing, we skills are used for this style of writing and will write our own.

Mathematics

We will continue to revise fundamental basic skills, applying these to problem solving and reasoning. We will apply knowledge of multiplication and division to enhance fluency of fractions. Later in the term, geometry, measures and statistics will also be focused on.

Science

In Science we will continue focusing on light. We will identify how light travels, how we can see objects and how this links to shadows. We will create our own investigation to explore this further. After, we will focus on health and lifestyle, including the human circulatory system. We will explore this deeper by identifying, naming and describing functions of the heart and blood. We will recognise impacts of diet, exercise and lifestyle.

Class 6 summer 2022 Our world

Class 6 will focus on the subject of our world, identifying different features from different areas around the world and comparing these. The impact humans have on the world will be a highlight for our topic, we will incorporate this idea into art and computing.

Art and Design

We will develop upon our drawing skills. We will experiment with different mediums and explain why we combine different techniques and specific drawing skills and what effect this may have on our art work. Further in the term we will focus on DT.

Music

We will continue to use our voices to perform a variety of songs as a class. We will use these skills to practice and prepare for our leavers assembly. Also, we will be looking at creating music using garage band, identifying notations and beats.

Computing

In computing, we will highlight and recap the focus of online safety and how to do this effectively. We will also develop upon our coding skills, explaining how they work and how we can detect errors and correct them.

Physical Education

In PE, we will be focusing on rounders and athletics. First, in rounders the pupils will practise and refine techniques for different types of throws and catches. They will then use these new skills in a game.

In athletics, the pupils will practise and refine their existing running, jumping and throwing skills. They will run for speed and endurance as well as recapping relay running. In all lessons, they will evaluate their own and others performances.

Religious Education and PSHE

In RE, we will be focusing on the question 'How does faith help people when life gets hard?'

In PSHE, we will look at relationships and the subject 'changing me' where we look at self-image, how girls and boys bodies change, positive self-esteem and finally the transition into high school!
