# Mathematics

During the first half of term, our focus will be on revising our understanding of numbers to 10 and how to write these in digits and words. We will practise counting forwards, backwards and show how to order numbers. We will be using mathematical symbols to help us to compare numbers and use terms such as greater than, less than and equal to. We will play lots of counting and number games as a class and in pairs. After half term, we will then move on to adding and subtracting within 10, learn about systematic number bonds and how to record these using mathematical symbols.

## **RE & PSHE**

In RE with Mr Gibbs, we will begin by exploring 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' We will talk about stories and teachings that show how loving others is important in Christianity and other faith communities. In PSHE we will be exploring 'Being Me in my World.' This topic will look at how to be responsible and how to recognise that some choices may have consequences.

## Physical Education and Forest School

In PE with Mr Gibbs, we will be learning all about 'invasion games.' Games such as futsal, basketball, netball and handball will be played whereby one team is attacking a goal or zone and the other is trying to stop them. In

Forest School after half term, we will be learning all about 'Superhero Creatures!' and all of the amazing little animals that inhabit our woodlands and school area. We will learn about where they live and how they help the world go around.

### English

This half term we will study the story, 'Juniper Jupiter.' Using the Talk 4 Writing approach, we will learn the story using actions, discuss the plot, characters and setting before inventing our own version of the story. After half term, we will focus on the story, 'Owl Babies.' We will learn how to sequence a story, write speech bubbles for the main characters, and eventually write a non-chronological report about a woodland animal. In our phonics sessions, we will begin with revising the sounds learnt in Reception class. We will play lots of games and complete activities to ensure we have a secure understanding of these before moving on to our new sounds. In our Talk 4 Reading sessions, we will share a range of books, discuss their similarities, make predictions and answer true or false questions.

## Music

In music, we will begin by creating and responding to vocal sounds, explore how to change sounds and have lots of fun experimenting with body percussion sounds. We will then move onto developing a sense of steady beat using instruments!

# Design Technology

In DT our focus will be on cooking and nutrition. We will design and make biscuits fit for a superhero! We will learn how to cut food safely, describe the texture of food and learn about the importance of hygiene and handwashing.

Our Science topic this term is 'Animals including Humans, We will learn how to identify the main parts of the human body, how are bodies help us, and link them to our own 'super' senses. We will also learn how to classify animals by what they eat and where they live. Finally, we will move onto learning how animals have powers of their own as they adapt

# Computing

In our computing lessons we will begin by focussing on programming. We will learn how to write clear algorithms, explain what inputs and outputs are and identify bugs in an algorithm and how to fix them. After this, we will learn how to explore and navigate through our learning apps.

## Art and Design

In Art, we will study Roy Lichtenstein. We will learn about his 'comic book style' images and learn how to recreate our own art in a similar style. We will also enjoy making superhero collages, masks and comic strip drawings using bright and bold colours.

## History & Geography

In our History lessons with Mr Gibbs, we will learn about important people from the past and will try to sort new and old objects. We also hope to learn about our local superheroes and people in our family who inspire us. In Geography, we will focus on 'Physical Geography.' This includes, describing a locality and naming key features associated with a town or village, e.g. church, farm, shop, house.

## How you can help

Please read with your child daily and practise any sounds or spellings that are set. Reading books will be changed on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Continuing to count forwards and backwards within 20 and practising recall of number bonds to 10 will reinforce what is taught in school. PE will be on Wednesdays and Fridays for the first half term.
