

English

This term our focus will begin with revising all the spelling, punctuation and grammar skills that we have learned. After, we will be moving our focus to writing and be looking carefully at applying our skills to a range of different genres. We will really be trying to showcase what we have learned and create some fantastic pieces of writing!

Mathematics

In maths, we will continue to revise and develop fundamental basic skills, applying these to problem solving and reasoning. We will continue to apply our knowledge of multiplication and division to enhance our fluency when working with fractions. Statistics will be a focus as we ensure that we are confident to read and interpret tables, graphs and charts.

Science

We will continue our focus on health and lifestyle through exploring the human circulatory system; identifying, naming, and describing functions of the heart and blood (we loved making our own!) alongside recognising the impacts of diet and exercise. Does your heart rate change depending on what you do?! After this we will be focusing on living things and their habitats. This will include looking at different types of habitats, classification of species based on similarities, differences and specific characteristics.

Art & Design Technology

We will be exploring the use of Propaganda and creating our own WW2 inspired propaganda poster using different materials. In DT we will explore places of remembrance and design and create a commemorative piece.

Geography & History

This term we will be going on a historical journey to explore one of the most important historical events of modern times: WW2. We will discover the important events and the impact it had upon the countries and their populations, focusing on the impact it had upon the country of Japan.

RE & PSHE

In RE we will be discussing the big question "For Christians, What kind of King is Jesus?" In PSHE we will be focusing on our 'Relationships' and then exploring a 'Changing Me'.

Music

Our musical focus this term will link with happy memories, celebrating each other's achievements, new horizons and moving on through song performance.

Languages

In French, we will use our knowledge of numbers to help us with telling the time. Later in the term, we will consider how to describe our physical appearance and personality.

Computing

Our computing topic will see us writing, recording and editing radio plays set during WWII, looking back in time at how computers have evolved and designing a computer of the future.

Physical Education

Mrs Haines will continue to be our PE specialist. We will be revisiting Tag Rugby briefly and then focusing on Rounders in the first half of the term before moving on to practise and refine our skills in Athletics in the second half. PE will be on a Tuesday.

How you can help

Reading with your child on a regular basis and discussing the book, along with practising any spellings that are set will be beneficial to your child's literacy skills. Continuing to practise recall of times tables upto 12x12 and associated division facts, along with practising telling the time will reinforce what is taught in school.
